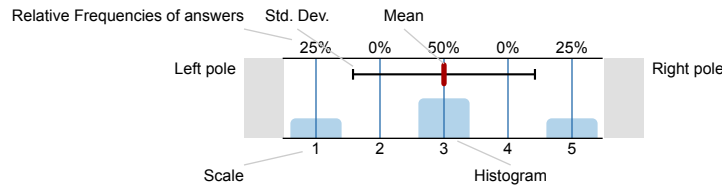

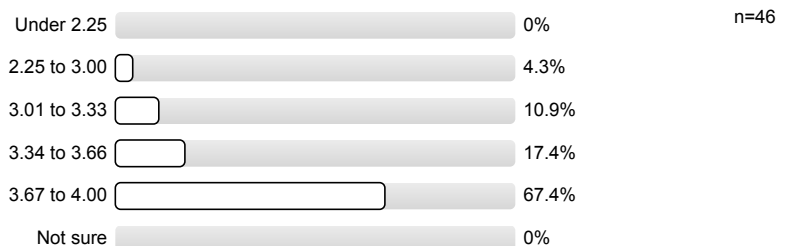

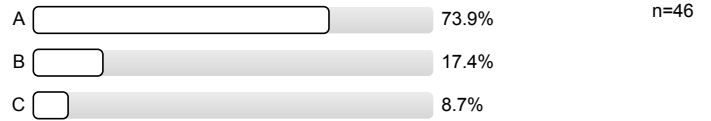

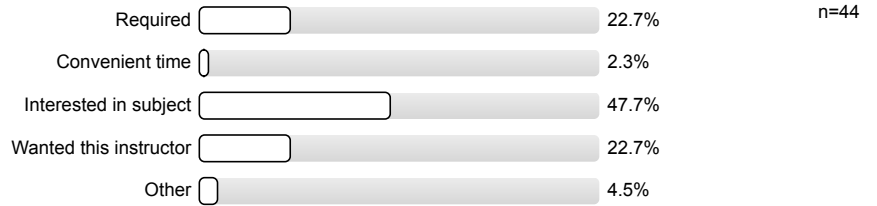

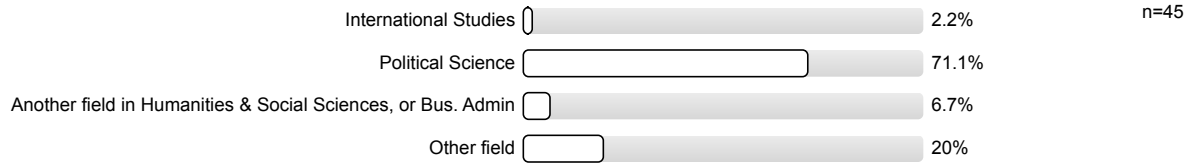

The Writing assignment are a little hard.

I occasionally thought that the written assignments were redundant with essay prompts on the quizzes. I would have liked maybe 4 essays/written assignments and then quizzes all multiple choice.
