



- 4.1) What were the best features of the course (e.g. readings, examinations, topics covered)?
- Dr. Schoenherr makes this course engaging and enlightening by bringing in guests who are honest and entertaining, by assigning fascinating, relevant readings, and by really knowing her field.
- Good, interesting and new readings.
- I had high hopes coming into this course as it is the gateway for my major field, and it exceeded every one of them. The readings were engaging, the memos were a rough adjustment but also incredibly helpful, and the assignments felt useful to my life. This course confirmed all of my reasons for studying the courts.
- I have to say, hands down, the best part of the class were the 5-point memos. I wish they were required in every other class I have taken. They did not only ensure that I was thoroughly prepared for class, but were extremely helpful for practice comps. This helped me to learn much more thoroughly and really comprehend information we were learning in class.
- 4.2) What were the worst features of the course?
- A bit too much work for each week. Would have appreciated if there were 5 instead of 6 readings for each week.
- I find that reviewing each assigned piece of reading is less edifying than discussing themes and insights more that can be synthesized, but I also recognize that Dr. Schoenherr was stymied in certain attempts to use "breakout groups" for this purpose by unwieldy technology.
- I would've loved to take this class in person, but obviously that couldn't happen at this time.

- 4.3) What were the best aspects of the instructor's teaching?
- Enthusiasm, empathy, and a willingness to let the class have fun. She knows a great deal about her field, and when she doesn't know something, she is willing to say as much. Also, the guest lecturers were phenomenal!
- Having the outline of the models from the beginning of the semester really helped me to better understand the readings. The instructor also created a class environment that was welcoming to questions, not only on the readings, but on graduate school in genereal.
- Jessica was a wonderful teacher. Right from the start she made class a welcoming space, and it didn't feel like there were any "stupid questions". She took time to explain confusing topics and professionalization questions as they arose, guided us when we got off-track, and helped us learn as benefited each of our styles and research agendas.
